We are counsel for the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance and Commissioner Marlene Caride ("Plaintiffs") in the above-captioned matter. Defendants Jessica K. Altman, in her capacity as the court appointed Rehabilitator of Senior Health Insurance Company of Pennsylvania ("Altman" or the "Rehabilitator"), and her successors in office, in their capacity as Rehabilitator of Senior Health Insurance Company of Pennsylvania, Michael Humphreys, as Acting Insurance Commissioner of Pennsylvania and successor to Altman, Patrick H.
